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Day 01

Arrival → Dambulla & Sigiriya

Distance - 130km

Travel Time - 2hr 15min

Sightseeing - 6hr



Dambulla is an ancient city where one can explore the wonders of nature and spirituality. Religious and cultural artifacts and the rural beauty of the city make it the perfect place to realize the island's unique heritage. Golden Temple World Heritage Site rich in colorful paintings and sculptures, Ancient Megalithic Pre-historic Cemetery, the spectacular Rose Quartz Mountain, and the food culture associated with the ancient Irrigation Civilization will surely amaze you.

Sigiriya is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and is dominated by a huge stone tower of historical and archeological significance. A fortress made of bricks and mortar with stairs rising from the mouth of a giant lion with ancient paintings.

ACTIVITIES - Visit the Cave Temple and Museum in Dambulla/Climb up the Lions Rock /Visit the Sigiriya Museum/ Prehistoric Cemetery/Rose Quartz Mountain

Overnight stay in Sigiriana Resort - Dambulla

Day 02

Dambulla Kandy

Distance - 73 km

Travel Time - 1hr 50 min

Sightseeing - 6 hr



In the World Heritage city of **Kandy**, The main attraction is the "Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic". This temple is the holiest shrine in the Buddhist World. The history of the temple goes back to the 14th century." This temple is famed for its elaborate woodcarvings, pillars, and other structures. Batiks, handicrafts, silver and brass items, clothing, gems, jewelry, etc. There are many shops in Central Kandy where you can spend your time on whatever you need to purchase.

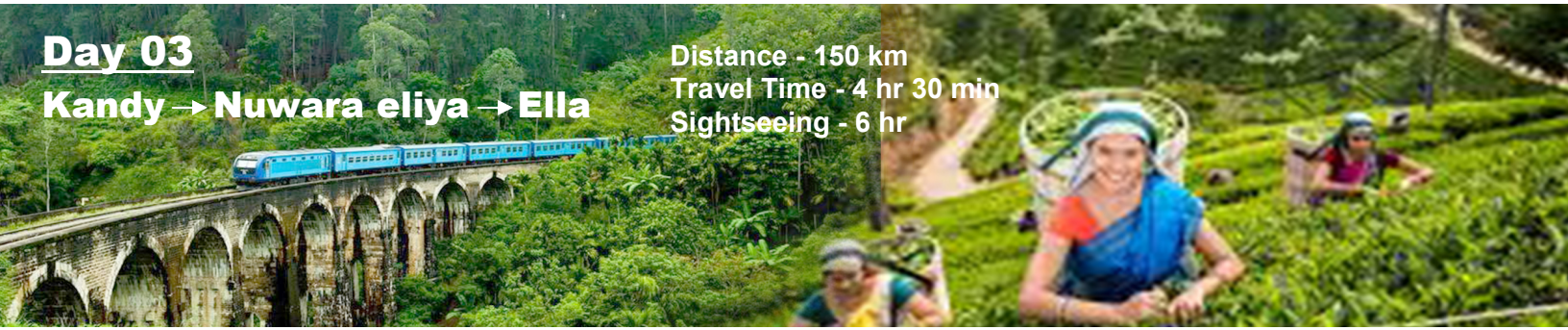

Day 03

Kandy → Nuwara eliya → Ella

Distance - 150 km
Travel Time - 4 hr 30 min
Sightseeing - 6 hr



Nuwara Eliya is a beautiful city with natural landscapes. The Hakgala Botanic Gardens and the colorful Sita Amman Temple are symbols of its beauty. Nuwara Eliya is one of the most delicious tea growing areas in the world. You will stop to visit a tea factory, tea plantation, water falls on the way to Nuwara Eliya.

Ella is a beautiful sleeping village with a small town in the hills. This lovely village with waterfalls is a perfect place to visit a beautiful valley that stretches far into the mountains. Ella

ACTIVITIES - Tea Garden Visit at Labukele/Visit Haggala Botanical Gardens and Seetha Devi Kovil /Enjoy the scenic view on a Train Ride from Nuwara Eliya to Ella/ Visit 9 Arch Bridge/Enjoy the night life at Ella

Overnight stay in HIDE-ELLA Hotel & Resort - Ella

Day 05

Ella - Galle

Distance - 187 km
Travel Time - 3 hr 20min
Sightseeing - 6 hr



After breakfast, visit little Adams peak, after visiting the Ravana waterfalls, we will depart to Yala. The eye-catching, jaw-dropping, and conspicuous peak is the one not to miss, Situated in **Ella**,

Galle is one of the UNESCO World Heritage sites. Galle harbor is a natural splendid harbor dating from the 13th Century, and became the island's Chief Port in the 16th Century during the period of Portuguese rule, under Dutch rule. It is the best example of a fortified city built by Europeans in South and South-East Asia, showing the interaction between European architectural styles and South Asian traditions.

ACTIVITIES - visit little Adams peak/Ravana waterfalls/Enjoy an adventurous Zip Line Ride at "Flying Ravana Zip Line/ Visit Galle Dutch fort/ Light house/ National Maritime Museum/ Fort Flag rock Bastion/Dutch reformed church

Overnight stay in Light House - Galle

Day 06

Galle Colombo Airport

Distance - 143 km
Travel Time - 2hr
